The City suggested that we look at alternative methods to fund the shortfall either by Sponsorship or other Grant Opportunities. There was no additional funding coming from the City.

A motion was made to Fund Up To the \$23,000 required for YRP to man the Controlled Intersection of Main Street Markham North and Robinson Street on the west with a Paid Duty Officer and Car as required by The City of Markham to issue the Road Ocupancy Permit for the 2024 Farmers Market to operate for the 2024 Season with the understanding that there would be efforts to secure alternate funding undertaken to support the financial shortfall the BIA would be incurring.
